Step by step guide on how to fit our UNDER DASH TRAY

PLEASE NOTE: Do not over tighten screws or bolts as this may crack or damage the plastic

Thank you for purchasing our Under Dash Tray. The kit contains: 2 dash trays (left & right) and 1 central mount.

2 First of all drill two holes with a 6 mm drill bit in the central mount at the same distance as the bracket from your handbrake lever. Hint: remove the bracket with the two large screws and use it as template.



- 3 Then at the opposite end, drill two 6 mm holes in the base of the Central Mount. the centers of the holes need to be 10mm from the back edge, and 15mm from the middle.
- 4 The corners of the Trays need drilling, again with the 6 mm drill bit. The centers of the holes need to be15 mm from the end and 15 mm front the front edge.
- 5 Turn both Trays on their sides and using a 4 mm drill bit, drill a hole in each of the molded bracket up stands.








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
6 Remove the 2 large screws from above the handbrake lever if you not has doing this before.



9 Screw the Central Mount to the dash using the large screws removed earlier and replace the handbrake handle




7 Then using a hammer and pin punch, drift out the pin and remove the handbrake handle.




10 Note:


If you are unable to remove the handbrake handle, you can saw the Central Mount as shown.



8 This allows the Central Mount to slide on.




11This allows the Central Mount to twist onto the handbrake bar.
Then do step 9.




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
12 Offer up one of the Under Dash Trays and bolt it into place using 1 nut, 1 bolt and 2 washers.



15 To attach the rear of the Tray, hold Tray level and using a 4mm drill bit, drill through the hole made previously, into the front bulkhead. Then screw the Tray in place.




13 Hold the other end of the Tray up level, and using a 4 mm drill bit, drill a hole through the tray into the front pillar.



16 Repeat the process with the other tray.



14 Then screw the tray to the front pillar



17 What you should be left with is a great improvement in storage space for your type 2,
